MELBOURNE, Australia – Author Carmelle Thorfinnson Cant is seeing the growing obsession with electronic devices and a corresponding decline in childhood experiences playing and exploring outdoors. With the publication of "Moonbeam Tracks," Thorfinnson Cant hopes to provide an enjoyable read with a fun, quirky and distinctly Australian flavor. She hopes that the rhythmic flow of the rhymes and the simple, playful themes will appeal to children and adults of all ages.
